

Information on researching historical persons in the Bayreuth City Archive

Some general information on family research:

The City Archive of Bayreuth contains only records relating to the city itself, not documents relating to places in the district of Bayreuth.

If your ancestors came from Bayreuth and you are looking for information and data on people from Bayreuth for your family research, the period of time you are looking for is important.

Information on births, baptisms, marriages and deaths <u>before 1876</u> can only be found in parish registers. The parish registers are kept in the respective parish offices, in some cases the parish registers are also compiled in central church archives.

Civil registers of births, marriages and deaths kept by a town or municipality, have only been kept here since 1876.

The older civil registers, for which the statutory retention periods have expired, are handed over to the city archive. The retention period is 110 years for birth entries, 30 years for death entries and 80 years for marriage entries.

It therefore depends on the year in question whether the registry office, the city archive or the parish office is the responsible authority.

The Protestant parish registers for Bayreuth (Evang.-Luth. Pfarramt Bayreuth-Stadtkirche and St. Johannis) are located in the Landeskirchliches Archiv der Evangelisch-Lutherischen Kirche in Bayern in Nuremberg (https://archiv-elkb.de/). Most of the parish registers of Bayreuth have already been digitized and can be viewed for a fee via the parish register portal Archion (https://www.archion.de/de/).

The parish registers of the reformed parish of Bayreuth are located in the parish office there (https://reformiert-bayreuth.de/).

The Catholic parish registers of Bayreuth are located in the Archbishop's Archive in Bamberg (http://archiv.kirche-bamberg.de/) and in the Catholic Parish Office of Our Dear Lady in Bayreuth (https://schlosskirche-bayreuth.kirche-bamberg.de/).

The residents' registration records of the town of Bayreuth were burnt in April 1945 as a result of the war. It is therefore <u>not possible to obtain any information from the registration records</u> in Bayreuth for the period before 1945 (family connections, people moving in and out). The newly created residents' file after 1945 is still held by the Bayreuth Residents' and Electoral Office.

House number, address and population registers of the town of Bayreuth

The registers initially only contain details of house owners, but from 1881 onwards the heads of households were also included.

Index of persons in the reading room of the city archive (pre-Bavarian/Bavarian period)

- Necropsy certificates A-Z, January 1891 to December 1906
- Military documents, cf. especially the "Bände" ("Volumes") finding aid
- Vaccination lists 1814 1914

First vaccination in the year of birth, revaccination at the age of 12 (with date of birth, father's name, occupation, address, school details for revaccination)

Only the years 1814-1820 are recorded in the index of persons.

Business records

Registrations and deregistrations 1868 - ca. 1940, trade register ca. 1826 - ca. 1907 (cf. Findbuch "*Bände*" ("Volumes"))

- Crosses of honor awarded to participants in the 1st World War (Bände (Volumes), B 2870)
